This exclusive safari is designed to follow the rhythm of the Great Wildebeest Migration across the Serengeti ecosystem, while immersing you in Tanzania's most iconic wildlife destinations. Enjoy luxurious stays, world-class guiding, and intimate moments with Africa's untamed beauty.

1. DECEMBER – MARCH

The calving: An estimated 400,000 calves are born which can draw a staggering number of predators eager to prey on the vulnerable young.

2. APRIL

The trek north: Herds move slowly northwards to fresh grazing.

3. MAY – JUNE

The rut: May is the mating season but still the journey continues, some herds move west towards the Grumeti River, and this is the first point on the route where river crossings can be seen.

4. JULY – OCTOBER

River crossings: The river crossings usually start in July, but the timing all depends on the rains. Although never guaranteed, crossings can regularly be seen at the Mara and Talek rivers.


5. NOVEMBER

The trek south: When the rains begin in November, the herds usually cross back to the Serengeti from the Masai Mara and head back towards the now fertile southern Serengeti. By the beginning of December, Ndutu starts seeing the herds return to calve, and the whole process begins again.

Balloon Safaris – A Once-in-a-Lifetime Experience



The flight concludes with a champagne bush breakfast, making it a truly magical start to your day.

Day 2–3: Tarangire National Park – The Land of Giants

Your journey continues into the heart of Tarangire National Park, a haven for wildlife and one of Tanzania’s most underrated treasures. Known as “The Land of Giants,” Tarangire is famed for its massive baobab trees and large elephant herds that roam freely across the sunbaked savannah. The park’s unique landscape, dotted with acacia woodlands and seasonal swamps, offers a dramatic backdrop for game viewing.

Over the next two days, you’ll enjoy thrilling game drives in search of lions, leopards, buffalo, giraffes, and an impressive array of birdlife. The Tarangire River, the park’s lifeline, attracts countless animals, especially during the dry season, creating spectacular wildlife sightings. Sunset over the baobabs paints the perfect ending to your safari days, while your lodge offers comfort and tranquility under the African stars.

Day 4–5: Ngorongoro Crater – Eden of Africa

Next, journey to the breathtaking Ngorongoro Crater, often referred to as the Eden of Africa for its extraordinary beauty and dense concentration of wildlife. This UNESCO World Heritage Site is the world’s largest intact volcanic caldera, formed over two million years ago. With its steep crater walls and lush floor, the Ngorongoro Crater creates a natural enclosure for an abundance of animals, making it one of the most unique safari experiences on the continent.

Over the course of two days, descend into the crater for full-day game drives across open grasslands, freshwater lakes, and acacia forests. Keep an eye out for the endangered black rhino, lions, elephants, hippos, and large herds of wildebeest and zebra. The scenery is as spectacular as the wildlife, offering postcard-perfect views at every turn. In the evening, return to your lodge on the crater rim, where cool highland breezes and panoramic vistas complete this magical chapter of your safari.

Day 6–7: Serengeti South – Calving Grounds

Begin your day with a scenic drive to the southern plains of the Serengeti, where endless open savannah stretches as far as the eye can see. From December to March, this region becomes the heart of the Great Migration’s calving season, one of nature’s most awe-inspiring spectacles. Witness hundreds of thousands of wildebeest, zebra, and gazelle dotting the landscape, many of them giving birth on the rich grasslands—an event that also draws a high concentration of predators like lions, cheetahs, and hyenas.

Enroute, enjoy a short stop at Olduvai Gorge, one of the most important paleoanthropological sites in the world. Often referred to as the “Cradle of Mankind,” this steep ravine has yielded fossils and ancient tools that provide key insights into early human evolution. A guided visit to the museum and gorge viewpoint offers a fascinating journey through time.

While in the area, immerse yourself in the culture of Tanzania with a visit to a traditional Maasai Boma. Experience firsthand the customs, songs, and way of life of the Maasai people, known for their distinctive dress, beadwork, and enduring traditions. This cultural encounter adds a rich human connection to your wildlife-filled safari, creating a well-rounded and unforgettable African adventure.

Day 8–9: Serengeti North – River Crossings

Travel north through the Serengeti to reach the Serengeti's northern corridor, a region of rolling hills and riverine forests that becomes the dramatic stage for the Great Migration's river crossings between July and October. This is where thousands of wildebeest and zebras make the perilous journey across the crocodile-infested Mara River, a heart-pounding spectacle of survival and instinct.

Over the next two days, embark on game drives along the riverbanks and surrounding plains, watching for herds gathering and attempting their crossings. Predators like lions, leopards, and crocodiles lie in wait, creating scenes of intense natural drama. The northern Serengeti is also less crowded than other parts of the park, offering a more exclusive and intimate safari experience.

With its rich wildlife, breathtaking landscapes, and the thunder of hooves echoing across the plains, Serengeti North delivers one of the most unforgettable chapters of the Great Migration. Return each evening to your luxury tented camp or lodge, surrounded by the sounds of the wild under star-filled skies.

After breakfast, transfer to the nearest airstrip—either Kogatende or Seronera—depending on your camp location, for your scheduled flight back to Arusha. Upon arrival, enjoy a farewell lunch or access to a day room (subject to your departure schedule), before transferring to Kilimanjaro International Airport for your onward international flight or Extension to Beach Holiday Zanzibar.

This itinerary is tailored to follow the movement of the Great Migration. The exact locations of mobile camps in the Serengeti will be adjusted based on real-time migration updates to ensure the best wildlife encounters

Booking & Payment Terms

Your booking request has to be made in writing and a 50% deposit is required. The balance has to be remitted at least 20 days prior to safari commencement.

All the payments should be FREE FROM BANK CHARGES

Cancellation policy

Reservations that are cancelled, reduced in length of stay or reduced in numbers are subject to Cancellation and No Show fees if cancelled within 60 days of the arrival date:

- 60 days to 30 days prior to arrival: 50%
- 29 days to 02 days prior to arrival: 100%
- Within 48hrs: 100%

Subject to Hotels and lodges Cancellation fees to apply

Tour leader:

1 bonafide tour leader after every 15 paying clients up to a maximum of 4 - will get free accommodation in half twin (i.e. sharing room). If staying in single, single room supplement will be charged accordingly. The tour leader is free only on accommodation, but other extras i.e. flights and all optional services are charged accordingly.

Drinks:

These are NOT included in our costs.

Visa

All nationals will require visas for TANZANIA. The cost of which is US\$ 50 per person per entry. We recommend that where possible your clients attain their visas in advance, although they are available upon arrival in TANZANIA.

Climate

The climate is hot and sometimes humid. From December to March, when the north-east monsoon blows, it is hot and humid. In April and May heavy rains occur with June to October being the coolest and driest period. The lesser rains fall in November. Temperatures sway between 25 degrees Celsius and 35 degrees Celsius and annual rainfall is about 20mm.

Baggage allowance

Baggage is restricted to 15kg per person on the domestic flights within East Africa. Soft-sided luggage or duffels are preferable to hard luggage for storage on safari vehicles and on aircraft used within Africa. Large suitcases of dimensions greater than 24" x 17"x 7" are impossible to store in vehicles and on aircraft and should not be used. (Baggage and personal effects are at owner's risk throughout the tour and baggage insurance for members is strongly recommended).

Shopping Trips

Driver/Guides will only stop at the shops/curios stall, which are recommended by Simba Safaris Ltd. We provide escort at no extra cost to accompany guests on shopping trips so as to help with recommendation and save.

Liability

Simba Safaris acts as agent for hotels, transportation services and facilities provided by other parties, firms or corporations and cannot be held responsible for delays, loss, damage, injury or accident, change of itineraries which may occur through the negligence of any individual or company entrusted with such service.

Children Policy

Children under the age of 12 sharing a room with two adults generally pay 50% - 70% of the rate quoted except on air, rail, safaris, adventure programmes or balloon safaris. Children under 7 are not permitted in any tree hotels and most tented camps. Some wildlife lodges and tented camps accommodate a maximum of 2 persons. Other restrictions may apply from time to time. Children rates are available on request.

Law

The Company's contract will be governed by and constructed in accordance with the law of Tanzania. Accordingly, each party irrevocably submits to the jurisdiction of the Tanzania courts to settle any dispute or matter arising under this contract.
